1. Pick One Thing To Learn

Improve your skills A LOT faster if you niche down to one topic and focus.

2. Learn The Right Techniques

It might seem counterintuitive, but you'll save time in the long run if you learn the proper drawing techniques from the get-go.



3. Take A Lesson

Hands down, the fastest way to get better at drawing is to take a class about the skills you want to learn.

4. Get Better at Something You Already Know How to Do

It's easier to refine the skills you already know than to start from zero and learn brand new skills in an area you aren't familiar with.

5. Study it

As you draw, think about what you're doing and make a point of securing those concepts in your memory.

6. Draw Everyday

Practice makes perfect is a cliché we all roll our eyes at, but there's a good reason why it has become so well known. It actually works.

7. Analyse Other Piece Of Drawings

No matter if it is a simple line or a complex painting. You can still be able to learn about other's techniques of creating a particular drawing.

8. Draw from a Reference

The fabulous sketches of renowned artists like da Vinci might be the reason that you started as an artist. However, you need to remember that you cannot become like them in the start even if you copy their sketches. Though they can be your reference.

9. Always keep A Sketchbook Next To You

Inspiration can come to you anytime, so you need to keep a SketchBook and your essential tools next to you.

10. Try To Be Intentional

As it is impossible to do anything without an intention. If you have decided to improve drawing, you can make a timetable or schedule your daytime accordingly.



11. Basic Tools That Are Essential For A Beginner

If you think that you will improve drawing without investing in some good quality tools, then you are completely wrong. The tools and material that you use while drawing has a lot of importance.

12. Portfolio/ Artwork Studio/ Artwork Storage



Don't throw away any of your artwork if you don't find it as good as Picasso's paintings. It is just that you are in your beginning phase and you will learn only after a series of bad artwork

13. Get to know about different types of Sketching

Hatching and cross hatching are the widely accepted sketching techniques that can do wonder to your drawing.

14. Blending

Blend! Blend! Blend! This is the secret key to make your objects look smooth.

15. Accent lines

This is not a necessary aspect of drawing, yet this practice of drawing lines below your object creates an additional style to it.

16. Learn to be Smudge proof

All you need to do is to keep a tissue or butter paper below your palm while sketching, it will prevent the graphite from smudging.

17. Skills That You Need To Master

Edges, Space, Shadows and light, Relationships among different objects and a combination of all these four skills.

18. A Good Quality Sketchbook & Paper

If you are someone who wants to work with Charcoal or pastel colors, you can go for a paper that has larger pits and grooves as it can hold on to the pigment much easily. While for the inks and pencils, you should try using smooth paper.

19. Drawing Pencils

Don't confuse your normal pencil with the drawing pencils. You cannot use anything except good quality drawing pencils designed for artists



20. The Job Is Not Done Until You Say It Is Done

Do not stop the drawing until you are 100% satisfied. When I believe that the drawing is done, I will scan it and put it away until the next day

21. Make Every Line Count

If you want your drawings to be the best they can, you have to make every line count. The more you

do something the quicker you will get at it. But do not lay down a line unless you know exactly how you want it

22. Draw upside down!

While it sounds and looks a little silly, drawing upside down helps you 'undo' the habit of drawing what WE THINK WE SEE as opposed to WHAT WE ACTUALLY see.to be placed.



23. Drawing using a mirror

Another way to refresh your perspective when drawing (aside from drawing upside down!) is to use a mirror. This is the easiest way to know where you are going wrong with your illustration.

24. Use the grid method

Creating grids before drawing is one of the best ways to ensure you achieve perfect proportion. This eliminates the guesswork especially when you are drawing from an image.

25. Use different drawing instruments

It is important to be comfortable with a variety of drawing media. Experiment with pens, pencils, crayons, gouache, crayons, chalks - the options are endless!



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
